

The Sanitation Division works hard to accommodate residents in the disposal of household trash. Each day the city dispatches four trucks to service homes and two trucks to service commercial accounts.

In addition to these services the Sanitation Division can provide 3, 20, 30 and 40 -yard containers for big jobs at an additional charge. Using a truck-mounted crane we can collect bulky debris and tree limbs. Click [Bulk Pick Up](#) below for additional information.

Special arrangements have been made with the landfill at I-240 and Bryant Ave to provide a discount to Del City residents. This method of disposing trash can be utilized if the resident has a truck or trailer. Click [Landfill](#) below to obtain additional information.

BULK PICK UPS

CALL THE SANITATION DIVISION AT 671-2873 IF YOU HAVE ANY DOUBTS WHAT CAN OR CANNOT BE PLACED IN THE CONTAINER.

The city has the capability to place several size containers at your residence to assist in removing trash and debris.

- The smallest container is the 3-yard container that is also used for commercial routes. The container can be placed near the curb at a resident. The container can be placed there for a one-time use or it can be emptied several times. Each time it is serviced there is a reasonable charge.
- The 20, 30, and 40-yard containers are much larger and can be placed in the driveway or in front of the home for up to a week.

Your point of contact for ordering and paying for the container is the Utility Billing Office located at City Hall 671- 2820. They will contact the Sanitation Division for availability and delivery date.

IF CERTAIN ITEMS ARE PLACED IN THE CONTAINER THE LANDFILL WILL REJECT THE ENTIRE LOAD. THEREFORE, WE HAVE NO OPTION BUT TO ALSO REJECT THE LOAD UNTIL THE ITEMS ARE REMOVED.

ITEMS SUCH AS DIRT, CONCRETE, HOUSEHOLD HAZARDUS WASTE, TIRES, BATTERIES, USED OIL AND OTHER HAZARADUS ITEMS CANNOT BE PLACED IN ANY OF THE BULK PICK UP CONTAINERS.

ROOFING SHINGLES CAN ONLY BE PUT IN THE CONTAINER WITH PRIOR APPROVAL AND LIMITATIONS.

LANDFILL

Del City residents can use a deeply discounted rate at the landfill located on Bryant Ave just north of I-240. To do so the resident must present a current water bill and picture identification.

The hours of the landfill are: **hours**
Monday thru Friday 6:00am. To 5:30am.
Saturday 7:00am. To Noon
Sunday Closed

The same restrictions placed on bulk pickup items concerning hazardous items apply to the landfill.

The phone number for the landfill is **672-7379**

The landfill has a strict safety program that requires everyone entering the facility and leaving their vehicle to wear a hard hat and a safety vest. These items can be rented at the scale house or can be brought with the individual.

Residents are reminded that Oklahoma State law requires the vehicle operator to secure loads so that nothing falls off the vehicle during transport. Failure to do so will result in a size able fine. This may mean that the load has to be covered as well as secured.

INDIVIDUAL ITEMS

Individual items can be picked up at the curb for a charge. Below is a sample of items that can be removed with a small charge.

Your point of contact for ordering this service is the Utility Billing Office located at City Hall 671- 2820. After payment they will contact the Sanitation Division for pick up.

PLACING YOUR TRASH AT THE CURB

Similar to many other cities in the surrounding area, Del City utilizes a completely automated truck to service residential areas. This system has reduced the number of driver injuries dramatically while increasing the number of containers that each driver can service on a daily basis.

The most important thing residents can do is to place the Poly-Kart at the Curb so that the truck's arm can grab the Poly-Kart.

GUIDELINES THAT WILL HELP US BETTER SERVE YOU WITH EFFICIENT AND QUALITY

Poly-Karts must be placed within **one** foot of curb by 6:00am on your collection day.

DO NOT place Poly-Karts within **five** feet of Mailboxes, low hanging trees or any other obstructions.

DO NOT park in front of Poly-Karts on your collection day. DO NOT put **items** on top of Karts.

ALL items placed beside Poly-Karts must be contained in BAGS or CANS. Bags and Personal Cans weighing 30lbs or less should be kept **five** ft away from Poly-Karts, with a **Six item limit**.

Completely fill Karts before placing **bags** or **cans** on curb. DO NOT stuff brush in karts. Brush must be cut Three feet or less and Tied in Bundles. Boxes must be broken down and tied weighing no more than Thirty lbs each.

DO NOT put **Oil, Hazardous Chemicals** or **Building Materials** in Poly-Karts. (Bricks, Boards, Sheetrock, Concrete, Rock, or Dirt).

An Additional Kart may be Requested for a fee of \$3.00 a month on your monthly Utility bill.
