PRESS RELEASE

On April 22, 2020 Oklahoma Governor Kevin Stitt released a plan to open the economy in Oklahoma using a three (3) phase plan. The plan, known as Open Up and Recover Safely (OURS), will begin Friday April 24, 2020. The City of Del City will stay in alignment with the Governor's guidelines. The follow is a list of businesses that are approved to reopen on April 24, 2020.

- Personal Care Businesses **(By Appointment Only)**
 - Hair Salons
 - Barber Shops
 - Spas
 - Nail Salons
 - Pet Groomers

All Personal Care Employees Must Wear Masks.

- State Parks and Recreation
- Grocery stores are encouraged to continue with special hours for vulnerable populations

All citizens are encouraged to continue to following safer-at-home guidelines, maintain social distancing when in public, avoid gatherings that do not allow for appropriate social distancing, and adhere to CDC guidelines and Executive orders regarding isolation after travel.

Employers should create plans to allow employees to return to work in phases, close common areas that do not allow for social distancing, minimize nonessential travel and adhere to CDC guidelines and Executive orders regarding isolation after travel, and accommodate requests of employees that are members of the vulnerable population.

For every fourteen (14) day period that hospital and incident rates remain manageable and level we will move to another phase that will allow for additional businesses and activities to reopen.

Again, all citizens and businesses are highly encouraged to continue with hand washing, sanitation, social distancing, and other safety protocols when on public.
