Housing Inspection Program

Abbreviated Inspection Checklist

Please note that this is a shortened version of what the inspection entails. For further information, please call (405) 670-7314.

- 1. Is the property free of all obvious code complaints? (TWG, MJT, BTL, DV, POG)
- 2. Is the exterior of the property in reasonable condition? (Peeling paint, rotted wood, etc.)
- 3. Is the interior of the property in reasonable condition? (Unsanitary conditions, insect infestation, holes in walls, holes in doors, etc?)
- 4. Are the means of egress clear? (bars on windows, double keyed deadbolts, piles of junk blocking doors)
- 5. Is there at least one operable smoke detector in the hallway adjacent to the sleeping rooms?
- 6. Are all outlets adjacent to sinks properly protected for ground fault? (kitchen, bathrooms)
- 7. Is there a legal heat source? (unvented gas heaters may not be sole heat source)
- 8. Is there a legal laundry? (missing washer drain, missing dryer vent or vent cover)
- 9. Is the HWT reasonably safe? (inadequate combustion air, missing TPR drain, missing burner cover)
- 10. Is the plumbing free from obvious issues? (evidence of leaks, missing fixtures)
